

SBIT 2006-2007 Goals:

1. To engage parents in opportunities to participate in and contribute to school programs and activities.

WBSS 2006 - 2007 School Goals:

1. Goal: Percent of students scoring at or above mastery on reader-text connections strand will increase from 33% to 60% by the end of the school year as measured by District assessments and the CMT administered throughout the 2006-2007 school year.
2. Goal: Percent of 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> graders scoring at goal or higher in composing and revising will increase from 42% to 60% and from 51% to 70% by the end of the school year as measured by formative district assessments and the CMT administered throughout the year and in March.
3. Goal: Percent of 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade students scoring at goal or higher in the CMT math strands of 11, 15, 25 will increase by 10% over the 2005-06 gr3rd grade scores by the end of the 2006 -2007 school year as measured by CMT's and periodic class assessments
4. Goal: the number of students in K through 4<sup>th</sup> grade at goal for reading will increase by 10% by the end of the school year as measured by the district assessments/CMT, as appropriate.
5. Goal: Percent of boys scoring at goal or higher in total writing will increase from 56% to 70 % by the end of the 2007 school year as measured by the CMT and student writing products.
